A REGIONAL DECISION

Ilf an Area Service Committee (ASC) or sub-committee there of requires financial support from the QRSC, it shall send the request in advance, to the respective Regional Sub-Committee with the following documents:

- Provide a complete treasury report, which includes, but is not limited to, its budget forecast with an updated actual, bank account balance and EPSS;
- Provide the requested invoice from the service or merchant;
- Provide a document explaining the request/need and stating, if applicable, the portion it is willing to disburse.
